

STEVENS POINT JOURNAL - THE BEST OF PORTAGE COUNTY RULES

Voting Period. Beginning at 12:01 a.m. (C.T.) on February 12, 2018 and ending at 11:59 p.m. (C.T.) on February 19, 2018, submit your votes for Portage County businesses or individuals in each of the categories on the “Best of Portage County” ballot. Submit your votes by going to <http://stevenspointjournal.com/bestof>, submitting your name, address, phone number, email address and any other required information to register, typing in your votes on the ballot, and submitting your ballot. Limit one (1) ballot per person, per day. Votes are limited to businesses and individuals that transact business in Portage County in the relevant ballot category. Votes must specifically identify the individual or business that you are voting for. Vague or ambiguous votes will not be accepted. Votes submitted in excess of the limits outlined in this section will be disregarded and disqualified. The Stevens Point Journal (“Sponsor”) reserves the right to disqualify any votes that it deems obscene, offensive, or that do not comply with the terms of these Official Rules. Sponsor further reserves the right to disqualify any business or individual at the request of such business or individual.

Winners. The one (1) business or individual in each category that receives the highest number of eligible votes will be named the winners. In the event of a tie, all tied businesses receiving the highest number of votes will be named by winners. A list of the winners will be posted on www.stevenspointjournal.com/bestof after March 24, 2018.

Participation. Voting is open to all individuals who are legal U.S. residents of Wisconsin and who are 18 years or older at time of voting. Your computer must accept cookies, or any successor or similar technology, which may be used for the purpose of vote tracking. Ad blocking software on your computer needs to be disabled so that it doesn’t interfere with processing your votes.
